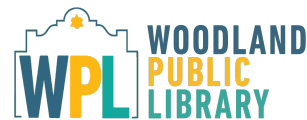

- The submitted entry must be the creative and original work of a single individual (no copies of cartoon, artwork created by other people or artificial intelligence).
- Artwork can include high resolution (300 dpi) computer-generated or digital photographic submissions or paper submissions using colored pencil, pen, paint, camera, or computer-generated art. Artwork should be one-dimensional for printing purposes.
- One entry per student.
- Only complete entries, including the design and application will be reviewed.
